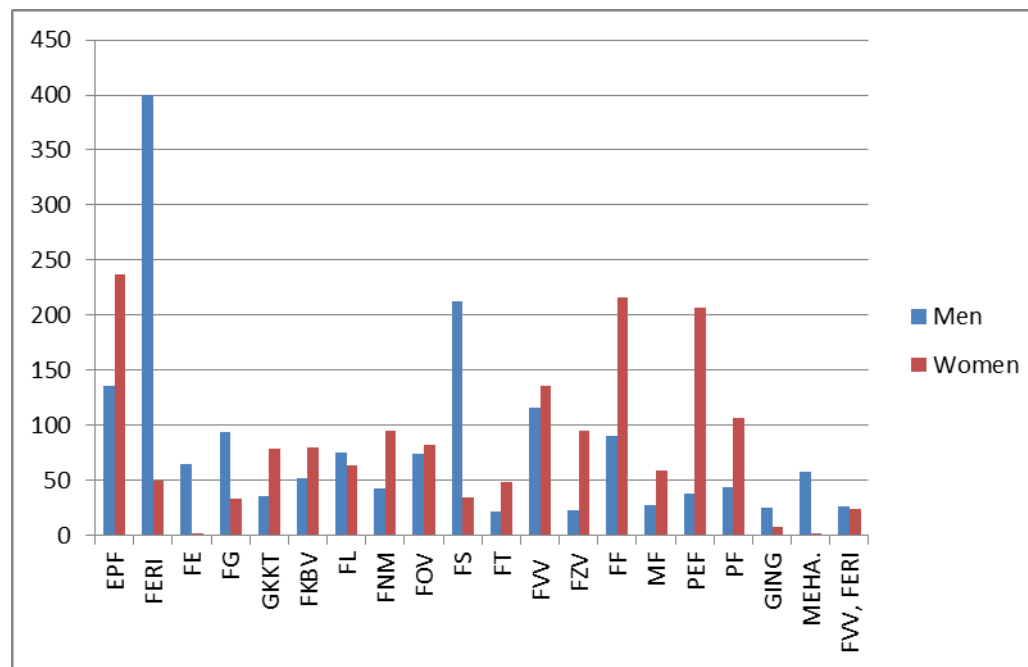

Accepted candidates by gender 2012-2013

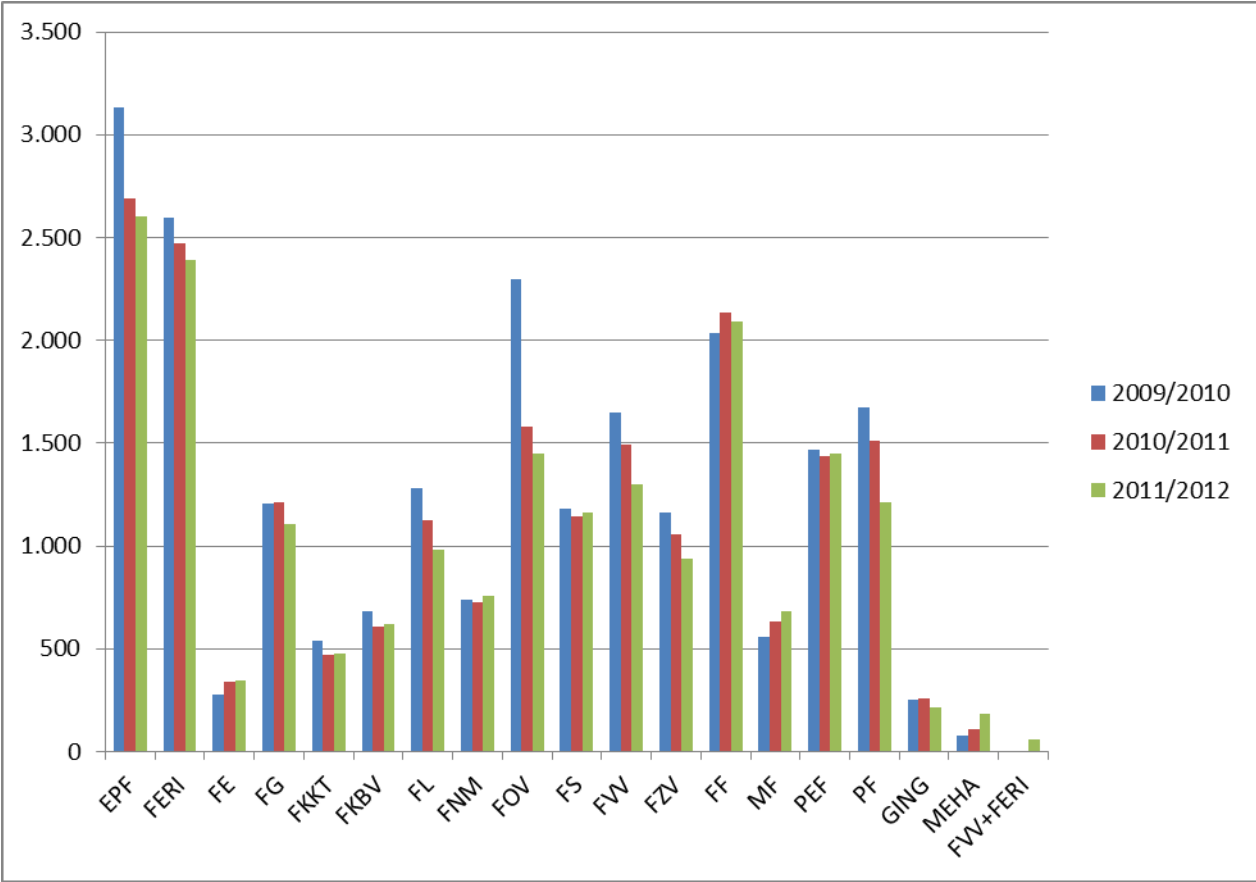


The number of students enrolled at the UM in the years 2009, 2010, 2011

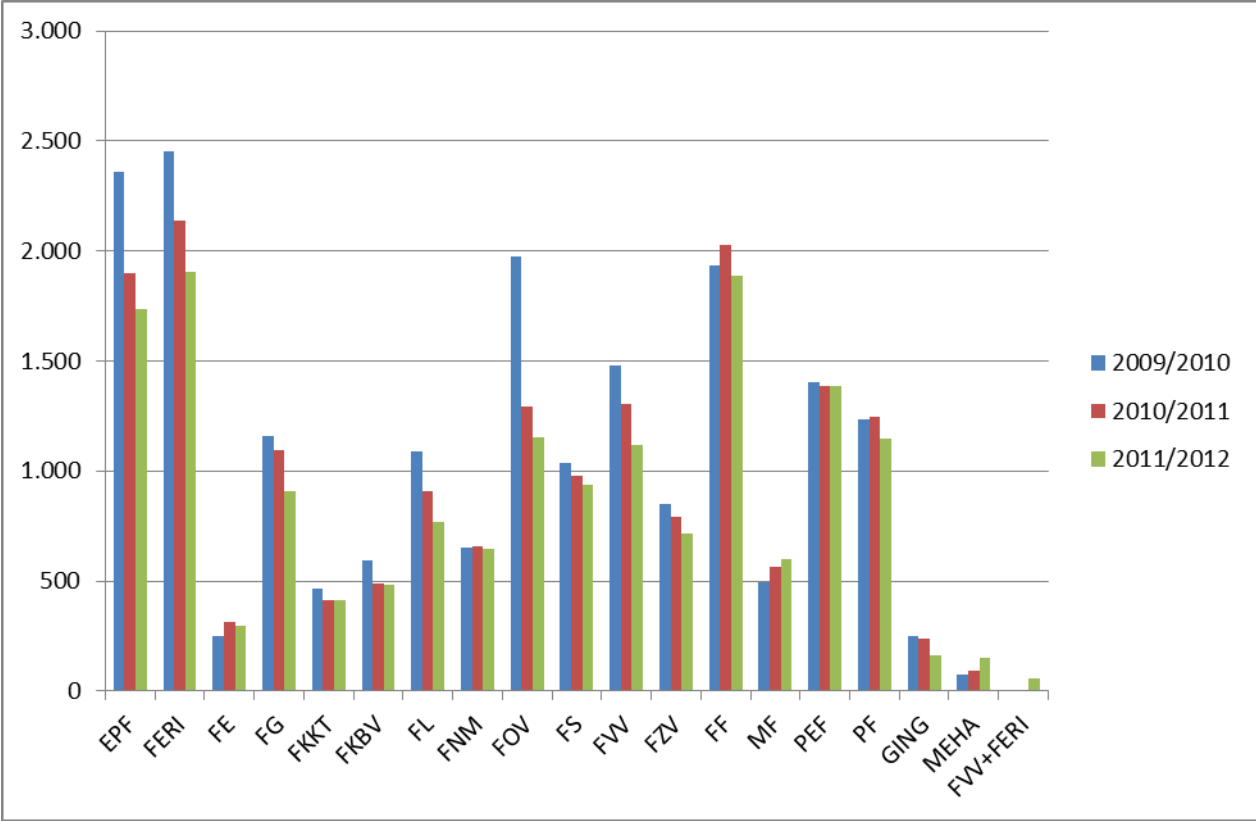

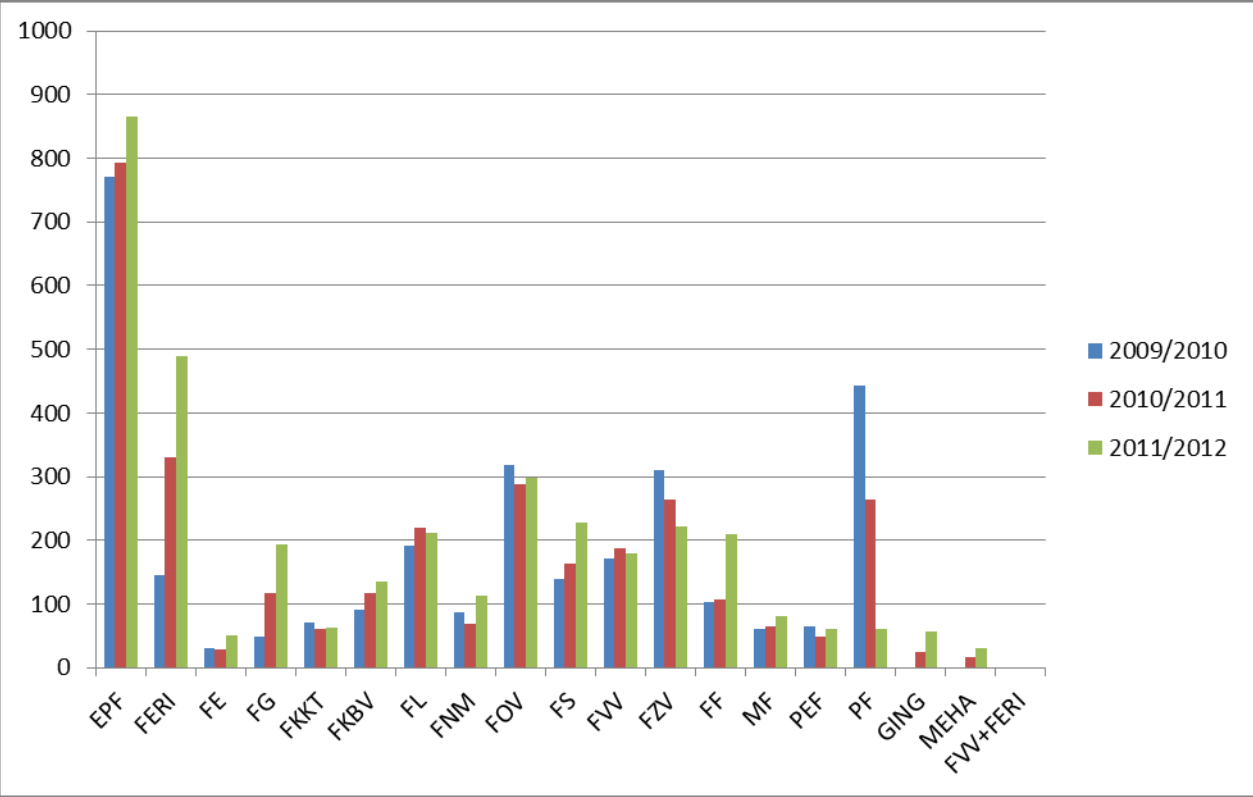
The number of students enrolled at the UM in the years 2009, 2010, 2011



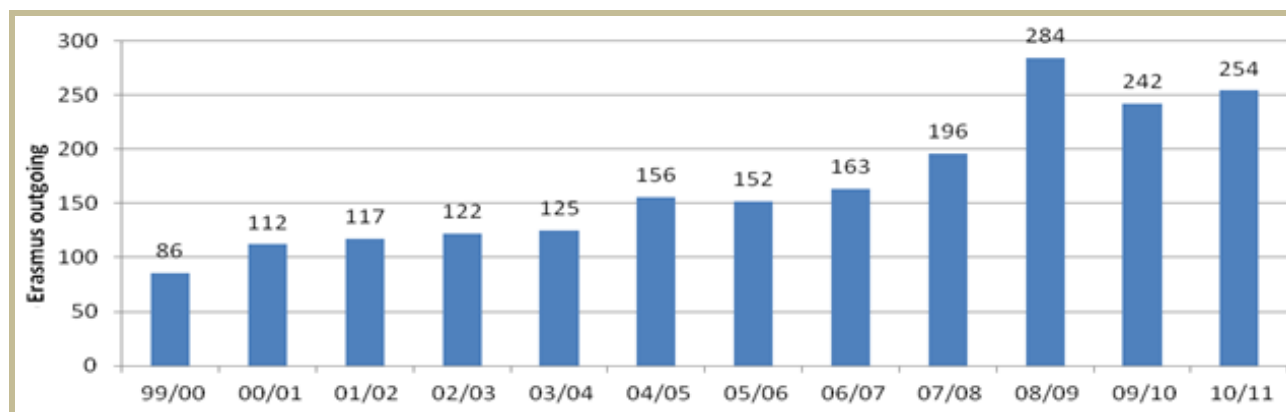
The number of graduate students at the UM in the years 2009, 2010, 2011



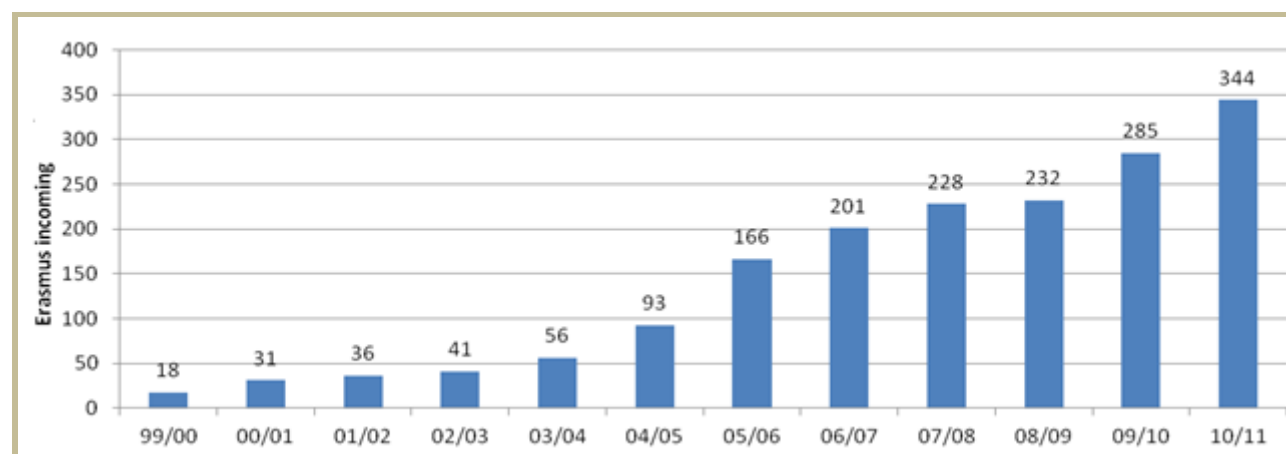
The number of post graduate students at the University in the years 2009, 2010, 2011
