### 2. DEFINITION OF RESEARCH PROBLEM AND GOALS OF DOCTORAL RESEARCH<sup>2</sup>

Starting point of research task of the early stage researcher and its position in the research programme, where the mentor is included, work hypothesis, research goals and foreseen result with emphasis on an original contribution to science:

The starting point of research is the PhD programme "Philosophy" (dept. of philosophy, University of Maribor) in the framework of contemporary analytic philosophy, based on the ARIS research programme »Contemporary philosophical perspectives: epistemology, ethics and political theory.« The candidate is expected to have some basic (and to some extent advanced) knowledge in the area of analytic philosophy - logic, epistemology, philosophy of science and also ethics.

Contemporary epistemology addresses some important questions that are relevant to both the individual and society as a whole. The fields of social epistemology, political epistemology and applied epistemology in general address pressing issues such as: the perspectivism of cognition, bias, (dist)rust, disagreement, testimony, ignorance, conspiracy theories, fake news, post-truth, the role of experts, the epistemology of internet, epistemic justice. Special attention is devoted to scientific knowledge and its social role. The candidate is expected to develop some original theoretical tools for the analysis of these phenomena (within the main theoretical orientation of the research programme, the epistemology of virtues and vices, including logic, advanced techniques of critical thinking and applied philosophy of science). The research combines purely theoretical, epistemological aspects with socially and politically relevant topics.

### 3. STUDY PROGRAMME

Foreseen study programme, to which early stage researcher shall be enrolled in academic year 2024/2025:

Philosophy, third degree (PhD programme).

### 4. DESCRIPTION OF WORK AND TASKS

Research training - working with primary sources, working in the editorial office of a philosophical journal, presentations at professional conferences (including organisational work), publication of an article in a scientific journal. But also mentoring students at lower level, TA (lectures) within the permitted workload for a young researcher, assistance in the preparation of research projects, participation in the public promotion of research in philosophy, participation in the work of the department of philosophy.


