Building a **new European model of university** that raises responsible citizens through technology.

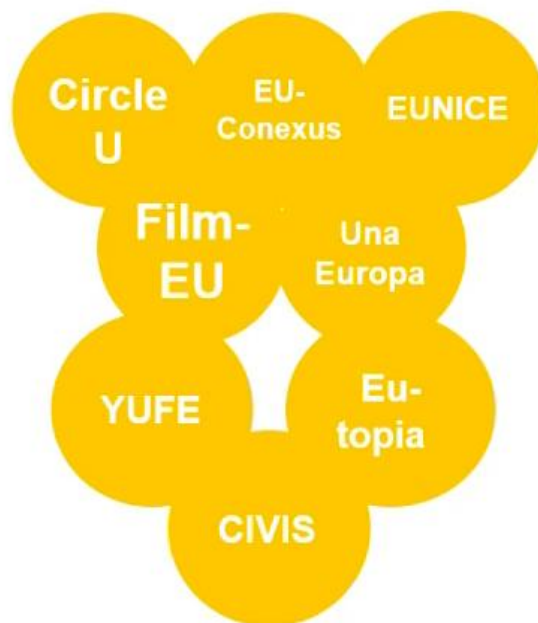

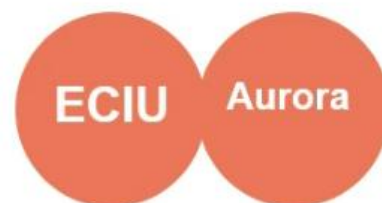

# *Main insights*

Transversal conclusion of 4 pilot Erasmus projects (2023-2024):

1. The principal objective of having a legal status is to:
    - + increase inter-university transnational cooperation
    - + create commons between, otherwise, independent institutions.
  - 2. No legal status fully fits the needs of university alliances**
- EGTC or EEIG = Temporary > Permanent solution

# LEGAL ENTITY, PROCESSES AND HARMONIZATION STRATEGY

*HOW THEY CAN HELP TO MAKE THE ALLIANCE MOVE FORWARD*

## EUT+ Governance

Rectors Board, Thematic Committees, Secretariat General, and other bodies and teams

Define policies, make decisions, facilitate agreements, ...

## EUT+ Legal Entity

Joint activities and services that add value

Will execute decisions within the scope of the entity



## EUT+ Members

Transformation of strategies, processes, programs, etc.

Carry most of the weight to execute the decisions, create new processes, transform the current ones, etc.



- EGTC - European Grouping of Territorial Cooperation
- Cross-border transnational cooperation
- 2 examples of EGTC
  - Cerdanya Hospital
  - Strasbourg-Ortenau Eurodistrict – tramway Strasbourg-Kehl
